The Rise of Western Christendom

RC 42494

A history of the first thousand years of Christianity. Traces its rise from the last centuries of the Roman empire to the formation of western Christendom and its spread in diverse forms across Asia Minor and North Africa. Explains how Christianity became Europe's dominant political and cultural force by the year 1000.

Carmody, Denise Lardner

The Oldest God

RC 17638

A layman's introduction to religions of the earliest civilizations and archaic practices that have survived in Buddhism, Islam, and Christianity. Also discusses ancient religions still being practiced by American Indians, Australian aborigines, and primitive tribes of Africa.

Durant, Will

Caesar and Christ

RC 10350

Part III of "The Story of Civilization." Surveys all aspects of life in ancient Rome including the struggle between Christian and Pagan forces.

Horsley, Richard A.

The Message and the Kingdom

RC 47641

Two historians trace connections between religion and politics in ancient times, relying in part on first-century archaeological evidence. They argue that early Christianity challenged a government that preached personal achievement and self-reliance but denied most of its subject's opportunities for advancement.

The Art of Happiness

Following conversations with the Dalai Lama, psychiatrist Cutler presents the Buddhist leader's methods for maintaining happiness. The Dalai Lama's basic belief is hope and connectedness. He offers genuine and lasting inner peace through trust in the fundamental gentleness and goodness of all human beings, compassion, and a policy of kindness. Bestseller.

Burtt, Edwin A.

The Teachings of the Compassionate Buddha

BR 07899

Millions now practice the Oriental religion of Buddhism, founded twenty-five centuries ago by Siddhartha Gautama of India. This book includes the early scriptures of Buddhism, as well as Buddhist thought in later centuries.

The Tibetan Book of the Dead

A new translation of a Tibetan Buddhist scriptural work describing the mind's projections immediately after death.

Sogyal, Rinpoche

The Tibetan Book of Living and Dying

RC 36890 / BR 09358

Buddhist spiritual leader Rinpoche maintains that most westerners need a fundamental change in attitude towards death and dying--they need to understand the truth of impermanence. He discusses practicing to prepare for death and helping others with death. He stresses his belief in the importance of the dying person's last thoughts being filled with positive emotions and sacred feeling while the person lets go of grasping, yearning, and attachment.

Van de Wetering, Janwillem

The Empty Mirror

RC 10589

After a year-and-a-half stay in a Japanese Buddhist monastery in Kyoto, the Dutch author discovers that Zen offers no dramatic revelations or salvation. He finds that the quest for peace is truly within him.

Watts, Alan

The Way of Zen

RC 12238

An exploration, based on early Chinese records, of the background, history, principles, and practices of an ancient Oriental philosophy.

JUDAISM

Bokser, Ben Zion

The Jewish Mystical Tradition

RC 17500

In a brief introduction, professor, rabbi, and author Bosker explains the general nature of mysticism, with particular emphasis on Jewish mysticism. Most of the book consists of mystical writings, including selections from such Jewish mystics as Moses Maimonides and Isaac Luria and texts from the Bible and the Talmud. All selections have a brief introduction.

Fackenheim, Emil L.

What is Judaism?

BR 07365

The distinguished Jewish philosopher discusses the effect of two momentous events, the Holocaust and the creation of Israel, on the Jewish religion and the Jewish people. With personal reminiscences and references to Jewish legend and midrashic stories, he then examines the meaning of the Torah to the Jews of today and addresses such issues as anti-Semitism, assimilation, prayer, repentance, and the Messiah.

Gross, David C.

[One thousand one] Questions and Answers about Judaism

RC 16852

These questions and answers, divided into ten chapters, encompass facts about the religion, culture, tradition, and history of Judaism.

Helmreich, William B.

Wake Up, Wake Up, to Do the Work of the Creator

RC 10300

Personal account of a special year in the life of a Yeshiva student. Incorporates Jewish history and explains Orthodox Judaism.

Himelstein, Shmuel

The Jewish Primer

RC 31282

Rabbi Himelstein has written this book for Jews, as well as non-Jews, who seek a greater knowledge of Jewish religion and culture. In question and answer format, he explains the Torah and the Talmud and discusses topics such as the Jewish calendar, prayer, the Sabbath and high holy days, various festivals, dietary laws, medical questions, and clothing.

Kushner, Harold S.

To Life!

RC 37461

Kushner offers Jews and Gentiles an account of Jewish life, which he describes as "being part of a very special community...made special by its relationship to God." His topics include Jewish customs and ceremonies, the purpose of prayer, the Jews' love of Israel, anti-Semitism, and a discussion of the roots of both Jewish and Christian beliefs.

Sachar, Howard Morley

A History of the Jews in America

RC 36162

Sachar, a professor of modern history, begins with the transplanting of European Jews to the New World and the establishment of New Amsterdam in 1654. He discusses subsequent Jewish immigration, especially from eastern Europe; challenges newcomers face adapting to a new world while retaining their heritage; milestones in Jewish life, such as the Holocaust and the Six-Day War; and Jewish involvement in society.

Sigal, Phillip

Judaism

RC 29914

Traces the development of Judaism from its pre-Israelite origins to the modern era. Includes the history of early Christianity, compares the relationship between the two faiths, and concludes with a chapter on the role of women in Judaism from Eve to contemporary rabbis.

Steinberg, Milton

Basic Judaism

RC 10368

The ideals, beliefs, and practices of the Jewish religion written for both Jews and non-Jews. Sets forth the significance of the Torah, and outlines the Jewish idea of God and the Jewish concept of the good life.

Trepp, Leo

The Complete Book of Jewish Observance

RC 17794

An encyclopedic introduction to the tradition and rituals of the Jewish religion that covers virtually all aspects of Jewish

observance. Rabbi Trepp briefly describes the historical development of each rite and the divergent practices among Orthodox, Conservative, Reform, and Reconstructionist Jewry.

Wouk, Herman

This is My God

RC 14388

Sketches the broad subject of Judaism, touching its history, beliefs, laws, liturgy, observances, and place in the American and world communities today.

TAOISM

Lao-tzu

The Tao

BR 05722

Translation of the sayings ascribed to the fifth-century B.C. Chinese philosopher Lao-tzu, who is credited with the founding of the philosophy of Taoism. This anti-Confucian doctrine holds that the ideal state is one in which man is free from all striving in accord with the natural functioning of the universe.

Lao-tzu

The Way and Its Power

RC 30489

The "Tao Te Ching" is one of two books setting forth the beliefs of Taoism, a philosophy that began in China in the fifth century B.C. The author's purpose in this translation of the "Tao Te Ching" with an extended introduction is to reveal what the book

meant when it was first written and to excite an interest in the study of Chinese civilization and thought.

Lao-tzu

The Way of Life According to Lao-tzu

BRB 10442

This is the Bible of Taoism, one of the three great religions of China.

CHRISTIANITY

Bokenkotter, Thomas S.

Church and Revolution

BR 12513

Traces the transformation of the Catholic Church from a conservative institution during the French Revolution to a progressive force in twentieth-century world affairs. Portrays religious and political figures such as Daniel O'Connell, Bishop Henry Edward Manning, Michael Collins, Dorothy Day, and Lech Walesa, and assesses their contributions to this change in policy.

Bokenkotter, Thomas S.

Essential Catholicism

RC 23352

Comprehensive one-volume presentation of the main doctrines and practices of the Catholic Church. Also focuses on contemporary issues in the church.

Catholicism and Politics in Communist Societies

RC 35405

Discusses the relationship between the Catholic church and socialist systems in Eastern Europe, Latin America, and Asia. Examines changes within the church from historical and contemporary perspectives. Sequel to “Eastern Christianity and Politics in the Twentieth Century” (RC 29273).

Clarke, Thomas J.

People and Their Religions, Part 1

RC 30878 / BR 08042

Discusses the histories, beliefs, practices, and celebrations of Judaism and Christianity. Includes short quotations from the Christian and Jewish Bibles. Easy reading for junior and senior high and older readers.

Colson, Charles W.

Kingdoms in Conflict

RC 33174

The ex-Watergate conspirator and born-again Christian looks at issues of church and state in a series of essays and historical vignettes. He argues that those who want religion to dominate in politics have gone too far, but that religion is still essential in the political world.

Colson, Charles W.

Loving God

RC 23729

The author maintains that most professing Christians do not really know how to obey the greatest commandment: to love God. To illustrate his thesis, the text draws on the teachings and lives of Christians from Augustine and Calvin to Mother Teresa and the modern evangelists.

Deedy, John G.

American Catholicism

RC 27625

A state-of-the American-Catholic-church report from the former editor of "Commonweal." Deedy focuses on the widening schism between the American church and Rome, and examines the rebellions and loyalties within major Catholic groupings. He highlights what he believes to be the growing revolt of the bishops, priests, laity, women, and minorities, and foresees a possible defection by many American Catholics.

Eastern Christianity and Politics in the Twentieth Century

RC 29273

A comprehensive history of Orthodox and non-Chalcedonian churches in the twentieth century. A group of historians and priests describes prerevolutionary and postrevolutionary church-state relationships in areas under Communist control. Among the churches discussed are: the Russian, Romanian, Greek, and Finnish Orthodox churches and the Armenian Apostolic Church.

Ford, Leighton

One Way to Change the World

BR 01501

The Vice-President of the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association attempts to find answers to today's perplexities. Believing that the Christian faith is revolutionary, he considers the state of society, the problems of modern youth, the failures of the institutional church, and the dissemination of the gospels.

Foster, Richard J.

Prayer

RC 37634

Foster, who believes that many do not recognize that they pray, hopes to increase understanding of prayer so it will become more "intentional in practice." He divides prayer into the three movements he believes address human needs: inward, seeking transformation; upward, seeking intimacy; and outward, seeking ministry.

Graham, Billy

Facing Death and the Life After

RC 29091 / BR 07179

Evangelist Billy Graham sees death as "the last enemy." He contends that instead of avoiding the subject we should frankly discuss its inevitability and view life as preparation for death. By understanding the Christian perspective on death, and "through our relationship with Christ," we can conquer this final enemy.

Haskins, Susan

Mary Magdalen

RC 42978

Scriptural exegesis, history, and art serve as the sources for this portrait of the renowned female saint and intimate of Jesus. Haskins demonstrates how through the ages the image of Mary Magdalen has merged with other biblical figures to become that of the penitent prostitute, a portrayal that epitomizes the subordinate role of women in the church and in society. Haskins reevaluates that concept.

Hobe, Phyllis

Never Alone

RC 25885

Spiritual tract of warmth and wisdom describing being alone as a time when God "challenges" one to "become the person He created." Hobe's thesis is that by leading a life of one's own a woman or a man can stop being the person other people expect and develop into the person she or he really is.

Hughes, Philip

A Popular History of the Catholic Church**RC 12465**

Survey from the early days of primitive Catholicism to the contemporary scene, including information about recent Popes Benedict XV, Pius XI, and Pius XII.

Idinopulos, Thomas A.

Jerusalem Blessed, Jerusalem Cursed**RC 35169**

An examination of the city of Jerusalem, where for centuries millions of Jews, Christians, and Muslims from around the world have gathered to hear the word of God. The author discusses the importance of Jerusalem to each religious tradition, the history of Zionism and the intifada," and the future of Jerusalem.

John Paul II, Pope

The Gospel of Life**RC 41275**

Pope John Paul II's Encyclical Letter of March 25, 1995, regarding abortion, euthanasia, the death penalty, ecology, and biological engineering. Bestseller.

Johnson, Paul

Pope John XXIII

RC 12734

Catches the quality that made Pope John so universally admired. Brings into focus the political, theological, and economic realities of the Church that shaped him.

Lane Fox, Robin

Pagans and Christians

RC 25510

RC 36107

The authors, two religion professors and one former seminary college president, examine the influence of Britain, France, and Spain on the development of Christianity in the Americas. Accounts of Jesuits, Puritans, and other resolute individuals who came to the New World demonstrate how these religious people adapted their practices to the communities in which they labored.

Marshall, Catherine

To Live Again**RC 14642**

Because of her firm religious faith, Mrs. Marshall was able to make a new life for herself after her husband's death.

Martin, Malachi

The Decline and Fall of the Roman Church**RC 18019**

A former Jesuit and Vatican insider presents a subjective history of the Roman Catholic Church from the time of Peter to the present. He argues that the Church has consistently sacrificed its spiritual power for political and economic ends.

Peale, Norman Vincent

The Power of Positive Living**RC 33609 / BR 08765**

Peale considers himself a happy person, and is concerned about people who are not. Now, as a sequel to "The Power of Positive Thinking," he offers further help for those who want to turn their lives around. Using letters, anecdotes, and examples gleaned from his counseling experiences, Peale offers ways in which people can

conquer their fears, triumph over adversity, and transform their lives through faith in God.

The Be Happy Attitudes

Be Happy You Are Loved

RC 23941

Dr. Schuller, the minister of the popular television program "The Hour of Power," counsels that "a life of happiness is found on the train called love." Lift Up Your Heart

RC 10062

Bishop Sheen analyzes the inner life of modern man and emphasizes spiritual growth as the key to happiness and peace.

Sheen, Fulton J.

Peace of Soul

BR 03300

A Catholic Bishop discusses such concerns as anxiety, sex, love of God, and various aspects of conversion.

Smith, Jody Brant

The Image of Guadalupe

RC 20432

Recounts the history of Our Lady of Guadalupe and analyzes the mysterious properties of the image of Mary which was imprinted on the cloak of a Mexican peasant in 1531 and which has since become the source of faith, strength, and awe for millions of people.

Stanley, Charles F.

How to Listen to God

RC 39962

For many people, the author says, the joy of hearing God speak to them is sometimes obscured by the noise and confusion of daily life. Stanley offers help in learning how to distinguish God's voice from others and how to listen to him through his scriptures, the Holy Spirit, and fellow godly people. He also shows ways in which God gets people's attention, and explains what can happen to those who do not listen to God.

Stanley, Charles F.

The Source of My Strength

RC 39969

Stanley offers a message to those who are burdened by emotional baggage. He believes that by giving painful memories and hurtful experiences over to Christ, a person can be free to move on with life. He offers words of comfort and healing to those who are

lonely, fearful, frustrated, or burned out; feeling persecuted, guilty, or inferior; or suffering from abuse.

Tinder, Glenn E.

The Political Meaning of Christianity

RC 31588

A philosophical exposition, by a political science professor, of the relationship between Christianity and political and social issues to Christians and non-Christians alike. His thesis compares secular approaches, which involve domination and coercion, with the Christian approach--a communal attitude, a willingness to listen, and a search for the truth.

Why Catholic?

Eight distinguished Catholics, including Andrew Greeley, Abigail McCarthy, and Fulton J. Sheen, reveal their personal creeds, discuss their spiritual struggles, and tell how Catholicism has shaped their lives.
